The team has made a blueprint of the plan of action accordingly and funds have been allocated for this philanthropic purpose accordingly, with the approval of the Governing Body of the college.

The first programmeinitiated towards this practice is the "Dengue Awareness and Garments Distribution Programme" in which a health officer shall inform the locals about Dengue, its causes, ways of prevention, cure and medication. Following that is the distribution of mosquito nets to the villagers and also garments distribution for the men, women and children by the college.

SKC shall be conducting programmes like this around the year and shall one by one include other villages as well.
