MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

JIS Institute of Advanced Studies and Research hereinafter referred to as "JISIASR" and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns of the second part.

(SKC and JISIASR hereinafter referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties")

WHEREAS

- A. Both the parties are desirous of entering into this MoU to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

Coordination:

Dr. Barun Das; Assistant Professor of Centre for Interdisciplinary Sciences shall be the Coordinators from JISIASR and **Dr. Nabadyuti Barman**; Assistant Professor & HOD of Department of Chemistry shall be the Coordinator from SKC. The Participants and Coordinators may change from time to time as decided by appropriate authority of the respective institutions.

SKC AND JISIASR HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING AS FOLLOWS:


1. OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this MoU and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each party's country, will endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop cooperation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit for various academic and research activities.

2. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter, endeavour to take the necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:

- a) Major Emphasis on Student Exchange Programs for Internships: As NEP arrived in our UG courses also, Internship is a major part of UG and PG curriculum, therefore, enabling both of our students to undertake short-term research internships under the guidance of our faculty, utilizing advanced laboratory facilities and research environment of both the institutions.

- b) Research Collaboration: Expertise sharing, joint research projects, co-authored publications, and mutual access to specialized facilities and instrumentation between the faculties.
- c) Faculty Exchange Programs: Allowing faculty members from both institutions to offer specialized courses, deliver lectures, and contribute to curriculum development in both online and offline mode. This will be enriching the academic experiences of students at both ends.
- d) Jointly organise international/national conference, Webinars, and Workshops.
- e) Any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties from time to time. The areas of cooperation may be revised by mutual consent.

3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
- 3.2 Each party will bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this MoU.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 4.1 Each Party shall undertake to observe the secrecy of confidential information received from or supplied to the other Parties during the period of implementation of this MoU or other agreements made pursuant to this MoU.
- 4.2 All Parties agree that the provisions of this Clause shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this MoU.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 5.1 The intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the respective national laws, rules and regulations of the Parties and with other agreements signed by both Parties.
- 5.2 The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of any of the Parties on any publication, document and/or paper is prohibited without the prior written approval of either Party.

6. EFFECT OF MoU

This MoU serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

7. NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein shall be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

8. ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

JISIASR: *for Jaitanya*

SKC: *Shresh*

8.1 This MoU will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of five (5) years.

8.2 This MoU may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.

9. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or disputes between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties without reference to any third party.

10. COMPETENT AUTHORITIES

The authorities are responsible for the fulfilment of this MoU between SKC and JISIASR.

The foregoing record represents the understandings reached between SKC and JISIASR upon the matters referred to therein.
